I. BUDGETED BENEVOLENCES

Those benevolences which can be used to fund the mission budgets of the Presbytery, Synod and General Assembly. These benevolences are credited against the church's benevolence acceptance.

- A. Unified Giving - These undesignated funds are distributed among the Presbytery, Synod and General Assembly per the percentage distribution formula approved by the Presbytery.
- B. Selected Giving - These funds are used to support specific items in the mission budgets of the presbytery, Synod and General Assembly as specified by the donor.
 - 1. World Missions - Remittances for missionary support. Should include the name of the missionary.
 - 2. Other - Remittances for other items supported through the program budgets of the Presbytery, Synod and General Assembly should include the name of the item. It does not include special offerings and extra commitment opportunities.

II. NON-BUDGETED BENEVOLENCES

Those benevolences which are used to support specifically named causes which are over and above the mission budgets of the Presbytery, Synod and General Assembly. These benevolences are not credited against the church's benevolence acceptance.

- A. Special Offerings - these gifts are for causes which have been approved by the Presbytery, Synod and General Assembly.
 - 1. Pentecost Offering - this offering helps to support children at risk and programs dealing with youth and adults.
 - 2. One Great Hour of Sharing- This offering is used to alleviate hunger and provide emergency aid to those in need around the world.
 - 3. Mother's Day Offering- This offering is used to provide general financial support for Homes for Aged.
 - 4. Union Seminary Offering- This offering is used to provide general financial support to seminaries.
 - 5. Peacemaking Offering- This offering is used to support peacemaking efforts throughout the church.
 - 6. Thanksgiving Offering- This offering is used to provide general financial support for Children's Care Institutions.
 - 7. Joy Gift- This offering is used to supplement the pensions of church retirees whose pensions can no longer meet today's costs of the basic necessities.
 - 8. Theological Education Fund- This offering is used to provide general financial support to the seminaries.
 - 9. Other Special Offerings- other approved gifts which are not listed in the special gifts section.
- B. Other Gifts- those items which have been approved through Presbytery.
 - 1. Hunger Fund- special offering to support hunger projects in Zaire and Ghana as well as local hunger projects.

III. Per Capita Apportionment- is used to fund the administrative expenses of the General Assembly and Synod.
