## Report of Council

Rev. Ingram Hedgpeth, Moderator

The Presbytery approved the following:

1. The Session of Center Ridge Presbyterian Church, Kenly will secure the deed to their manse in order to negotiate the sale of their property.
2. The Session of the Davie Street Presbyterian Church, Raleigh, may sell their manse valued at approximately \$89,000, and to purchase property close to the church for additional parking for \$37,000.
3. The Task Force for Grace Chapel Fellowship to continue as an Administrative Commission to organize the Grace Chapel Church.
4. The Durham Area churches meet and organize as a group to work together in mutual support and empowerment.
5. The Committee On Ministry and Leadership Division revisit the Cluster concept.
6. The Presbytery of New Hope become an Associate Member of the Association of Presbyterian Colleges and Universities.
7. The Presbytery provide labels for ministers to First Presbyterian Church, Greensboro, for minister continuing education information.
8. Neuse Forest Presbyterian Church may apply for a Small Church Grant from the Synod of the Mid-Atlantic in the amount of \$2,500 for a new roof on the fellowship hall.
9. The Administrative Commission for Clayton Presbyterian Fellowship was given permission to purchase property of up to \$50,000 per acre, with a feasibility study to be conducted prior to any land purchase.
10. Church Development and Evangelism will continue to fund Northgate Presbyterian Church through 2007 and continue to support the Durham Hispanic Ministry that worships at Northgate.
11. The Presbytery of New Hope support Saint Andrews Presbyterian College with a note and contribution of \$3,000.
12. The Proposed Challenge Budget for 2008 be set at \$1,929,000.
13. The following standing rule:  
Standing Rule for Assumption of Original Jurisdiction by New Hope Presbytery  
In Certain Cases of Judicial Process
  - (1) Upon receipt of a written request from a session that Presbytery assume original jurisdiction of a remedial or disciplinary matter (including without limitation a prospective matter that involves the appointment of an Investigating Committee), Presbytery Council may agree in its discretion on behalf of Presbytery to accept original jurisdiction as requested.
  - (2) A written request from a session for such assumption of original jurisdiction must state the reasons for such request and include a statement of the willingness of the requesting session to

reimburse Presbytery for the expenses of any resulting investigation and ensuing trial.

- (3) If the matter upon which assumption of original jurisdiction has been requested is such that an Investigating Committee needs to be appointed, then the Moderator of Presbytery Council in consultation with the Stated Clerk shall proceed to appoint an Investigating Committee as provided in the Book of Order and in any other Standing Rule then in effect.
- (4) Upon receipt of a written accusation against a member of the presbytery, the Stated Clerk will contact the Committee on Ministry Moderator and the Moderator of the Presbytery and they will appoint an investigative committee and report their action to the next stated meeting of the presbytery.
