Reverend Jim Hodge reported on the Overture submitted by the Presbytery "OVERTURE to move the PCUSA from a four tiered to a three tiered mission/governance system by eliminating the middle governing body of synod by deleting Chapter 12 and G-3:4." and additional overtures endorsed by the Presbytery. Betsy Wisniewski and David Smith gave report on their experience at the General Assembly. A booklet of all commissioner reports was distributed to all in attendance.
