Call to Order

The meeting was called to order with prayer at 9:02AM by Moderator Peter Bynum

Quorum

Pursuant to BOO G-3.304 the required number for a quorum in the presbytery is 3 ministers and 3 elders, provided that at least three churches are represented by elders. A quorum was determined.

Docket

 - Pastor/Educator Retreat will be held October 12-14 at Trinity Center, Salter Path and led by Dr. John Carroll, Union Theological Seminary.
